



SAINT ANN CATHOLIC SCHOOL UNIFORM & DRESS CODE 2025-2026

Saint Ann Catholic School has a school uniform for the following reasons: to create a sense of cohesion among the students, to foster school spirit, to promote virtue, and to create an appropriate formal atmosphere in the academy. The virtues that we seek to promote include modesty, humility, and decorum. The uniforms and the rules regarding haircuts, makeup, jewelry, and other accessories encourage students to cast aside vanity in favor of presenting themselves neatly and humbly before God and the community.

Saint Ann Catholic School has a new school logo and is working with a new uniform provider this year. Some items purchased from our old uniform provider may continue to be used, but only if the items are included in the new code established for this school year – not all items previously allowed will be allowed this year.

Land's End is the new provider for our uniforms. To purchase, find the link to our online store on our website under *Family Portal*. Items in **bold** are required.

On school Mass days, students may NOT wear shorts.

Some school-related events, such as graduation, dances, and field trips will have specific dress code requirements that will be provided at the time of the event.

If an item is not listed, it is not allowed.

All decisions regarding the school uniform and dress code rest with the principal. Contact the office with questions.

Please print the student's name on all articles of clothing worn to school.

BOYS

Grooming

- All clothing and persons must be clean, odor free, tidy, and well-mended (no torn or worn items).
- Hair must be neat, in a traditional style, non-distracting or attention seeking, and must remain out of the eyes without assistance. Extreme styles, colors, or patterns are not permitted.
- Jewelry – A watch and/or a religious necklace are allowed.
- No facial hair, makeup, henna tattoos allowed.

“Regular Uniform Days” – Code for these days is as follows:

- **Shoes**
 - Grade 4-5 – tennis/athletic, black or brown in color, low top
 - Grade K4-3 – any plain, low-top tennis shoe of no more than two colors
 - NO lights, sounds, beads, sequins, characters, or wheels are allowed.
- **Socks**
 - solid navy, black, or white, crew length (mid-calf)
- **Pants or Shorts** – khaki, those available on our Land’s End page or identical in style and color.
- **Belt** – black or brown leather (**required for grades 4-5**; optional for K4-3), belt should match shoes
- Undershirt (optional) – white plain short-sleeve only
- **Polo Shirt**
 - Land’s End grey, long or short sleeve, Saint Ann logo
 - OLD ALLOWED: green long or short sleeve, old Saint Ann logo
- **Sweater**
 - Land’s End green, V-neck pullover, sweater vest, or cardigan (button or zipper), Saint Ann logo
 - OLD ALLOWED: green V-neck pullover, sweater vest, or cardigan (button), old Saint Ann logo
 - NO fleece zip jackets, quarter zips, or sweatshirts allowed.

“Denim Day” – Code for these days is as follows:

- Tennis shoes, no open toed or open heeled shoes, no sandals, flip flops, crocs, or heels.
- Denim Jeans
- T-shirt – Land’s End grey, long or short sleeve, Saint Ann round logo
- T-shirt, OLD ALLOWED – green, old Saint Ann logo
- Sweatshirt – Land’s End green, Saint Ann round logo
- Sweatshirt, OLD ALLOWED – green, old Saint Ann logo

“Out of Uniform Days” – Code for these days is as follows:

- Tennis shoes, no open toed or open heeled shoes, no sandals, flip flops, crocs, or heels.
- Pants, shorts, or skirts must be similar in length to uniform requirements.
- Shirts must have sleeves and reach up to the neck, no spaghetti straps or tank tops.
- Clothing may not contain messages or images that are vulgar, unsightly, immoral or not in keeping with the teaching of our faith. It must be modest and appropriate for a school setting.

GIRLS

Grooming:

- All clothing and persons must be clean, odor free, tidy, and well-mended (no torn or worn items).
- Hair must be neat, may not be distracting, and must remain out of the eyes without assistance. Extreme hair coloring and bleaching with non-natural colors and/or patterns are not permitted.
- Jewelry – Stud earrings are allowed. One ring, one bracelet or watch, and/or a religious necklace allowed.
- Makeup, henna tattoos and nail polish are not permitted.

“Regular Uniform Days” – Code for these days is as follows:

- **Shoes**
 - Grade 4-5 – tennis/athletic, black or brown in color, low top
 - Grade K4-3 – any plain, low-top tennis shoe of no more than two colors
 - NO lights, sounds, beads, sequins, characters, or wheels are allowed.
- **Socks/Tights**
 - With Skirts, Skorts, & Jumpers – solid navy knee-high socks or solid navy leggings/tights.
 - With Shorts or Pants – solid navy, black, or white crew-length (mid-calf)
- **Jumper or Skort – K4-3 grade**
 - Land’s End plaid, must reach top of knee, OLD ALLOWED: must reach top of knee
- **Skirt – 4-5 grade**
 - Land’s End plaid, must reach below the knee
- **Pants or Shorts** – khaki, those available on our Land’s End page or identical in style and color.
- **Belt** – black or brown leather (with pants or shorts, **required for grades 4-5**; optional for K4-3), belt should match shoes
- Undershirt (optional) – white plain short-sleeve only
- **Polo Shirt** –
 - Land’s End grey, long or short sleeve, Saint Ann logo, OLD ALLOWED: green long or short sleeve, old Saint Ann logo
- **Sweater**
 - Land’s End green, V-neck pullover, sweater vest, or cardigan (button or zipper), Saint Ann logo
 - OLD ALLOWED: green V-neck pullover, sweater vest, or cardigan (button), old Saint Ann logo
 - NO fleece zip jackets or sweatshirts allowed.

“Denim Days” – Code for these days is as follows:

- Tennis shoes, no open toed or open heeled shoes, no sandals, flip flops, crocs, or heels.
- Denim Jeans or skirt reaching below the knee.
- T-shirt – Land’s End grey, long or short sleeve, Saint Ann round logo
- T-shirt, OLD ALLOWED – green, old Saint Ann logo
- Sweatshirt – Land’s End green, Saint Ann round logo
- Sweatshirt, OLD ALLOWED – green, old Saint Ann logo

“Out of Uniform Days” – Code for these days is as follows:

- Tennis shoes, no open toed or open heeled shoes, no sandals, flip flops, crocs, or heels.
- Pants, shorts, or skirts must be similar in length to uniform requirements.
- Shirts must have sleeves and reach up to the neck, no spaghetti straps or tank tops.
- Clothing may not contain messages that are not in keeping with the teaching of our faith. It must be modest and appropriate for a school setting.
